**Evaluation Methods Used:** Testing of Enterprise involved 287 scenarios from 228 workflows requiring extensive use of leading assistive technology, such as screen readers (NVDA, version: 2020.1 & VoiceOver), and the keyboard as well.

The following tools and assistive technologies were used:

- Manual testing with Safari and VoiceOver running on the macOS operating system.
- Manual testing with Firefox and NVDA running on Windows operating system.
- Using magnification on Chrome.

Accessibility testers performed the test using accessibility browser extensions, code inspection, and color contrast checkers keeping WCAG 2.1 guidelines in mind.
